Understanding True Wealth

The Kingdom of God operates on principles that are opposite to worldly systems. True wealth is not measured by accumulation, but by stewardship. God is the Source, not money.

The Principle of Stewardship

You are a steward, not an owner. Everything you have belongs to God. Your responsibility is to manage His resources wisely and multiply them for Kingdom purposes.

Seedtime and Harvest

The Kingdom operates on agricultural principles. What you sow, you will reap. Sow generously into good ground, and you will reap an abundant harvest (Galatians 6:7-9).

The Tithe is Holy

The first 10% belongs to God. It's not yours to keep. Malachi 3:10 promises that when you bring the whole tithe, God will open the windows of heaven.

Offerings Release Breakthrough

Beyond the tithe, offerings are seeds you plant for specific harvests. Give with expectation, knowing that God rewards those who diligently seek Him (Hebrews 11:6).

Work as Unto the Lord

Your job is not your source - God is. But work is honorable and required in the Kingdom. Whatever you do, work heartily as for the Lord (Colossians 3:23).

The Debt Trap

The borrower is servant to the lender (Proverbs 22:7). Kingdom citizens avoid unnecessary debt and work to become debt-free, which releases them to give freely.
